Who is eligible to apply?

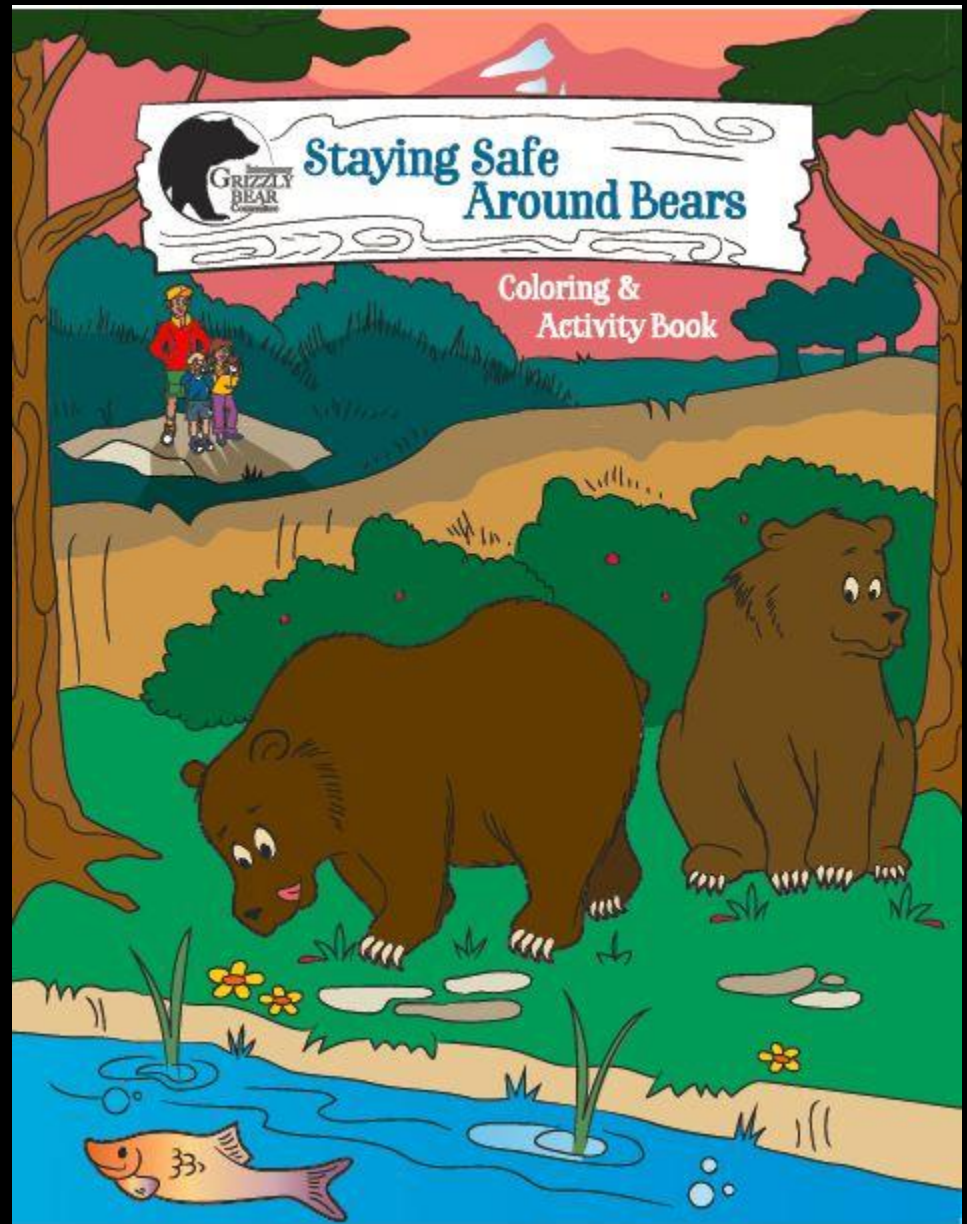
