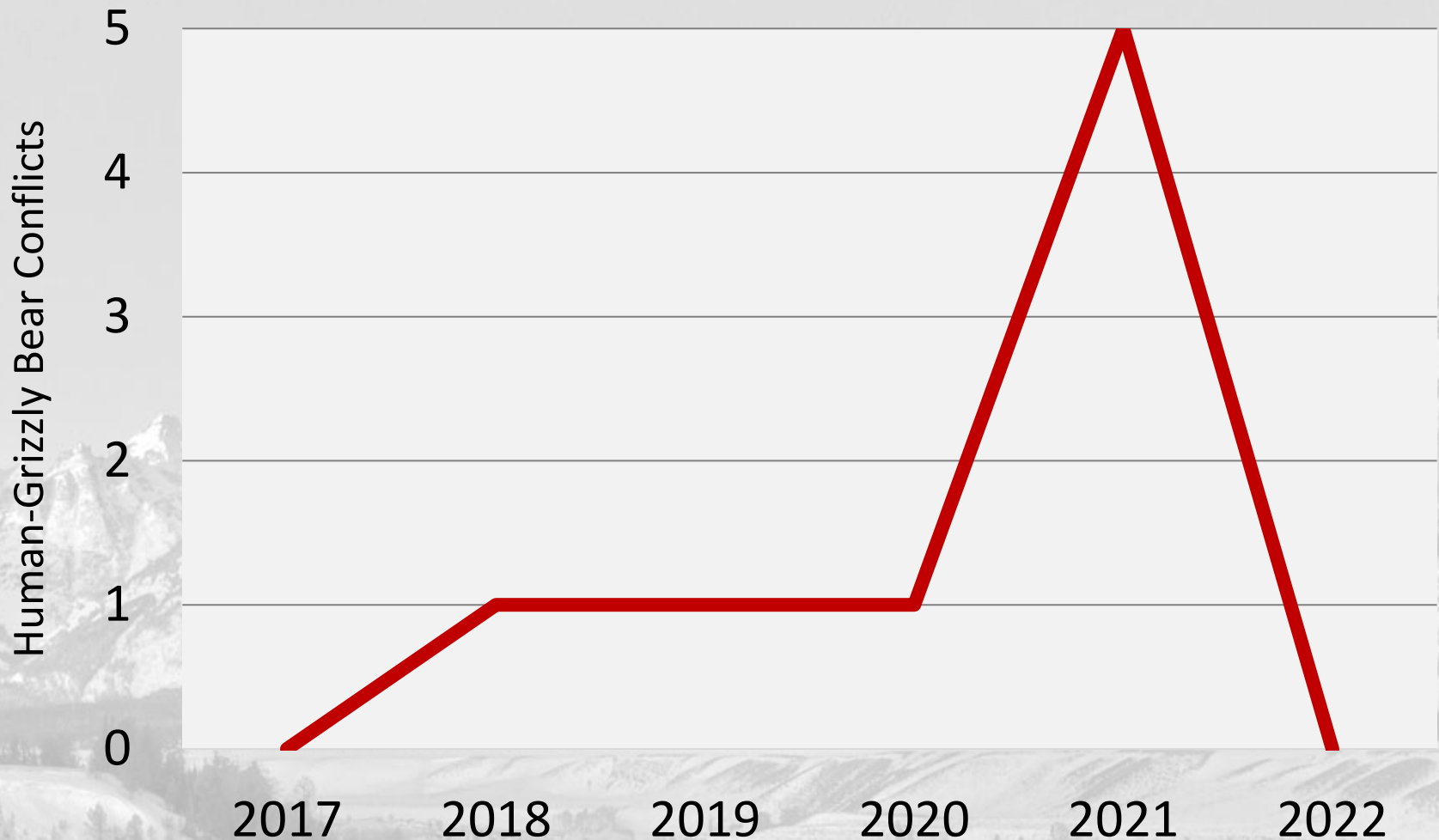

Human-Grizzly Bear Conflicts (2017-2022)





Proactive Efforts (2022)

Temporary area closures	8
Trailhead bear safety signs	38
Bear frequenting area warnings	2
Hazing from developed areas and roadways	22
Ungulate carcass removals	59
Located unsecured attractants	2,073
Bear-resistant trash/recycling infrastructure	100%

to **1,067**





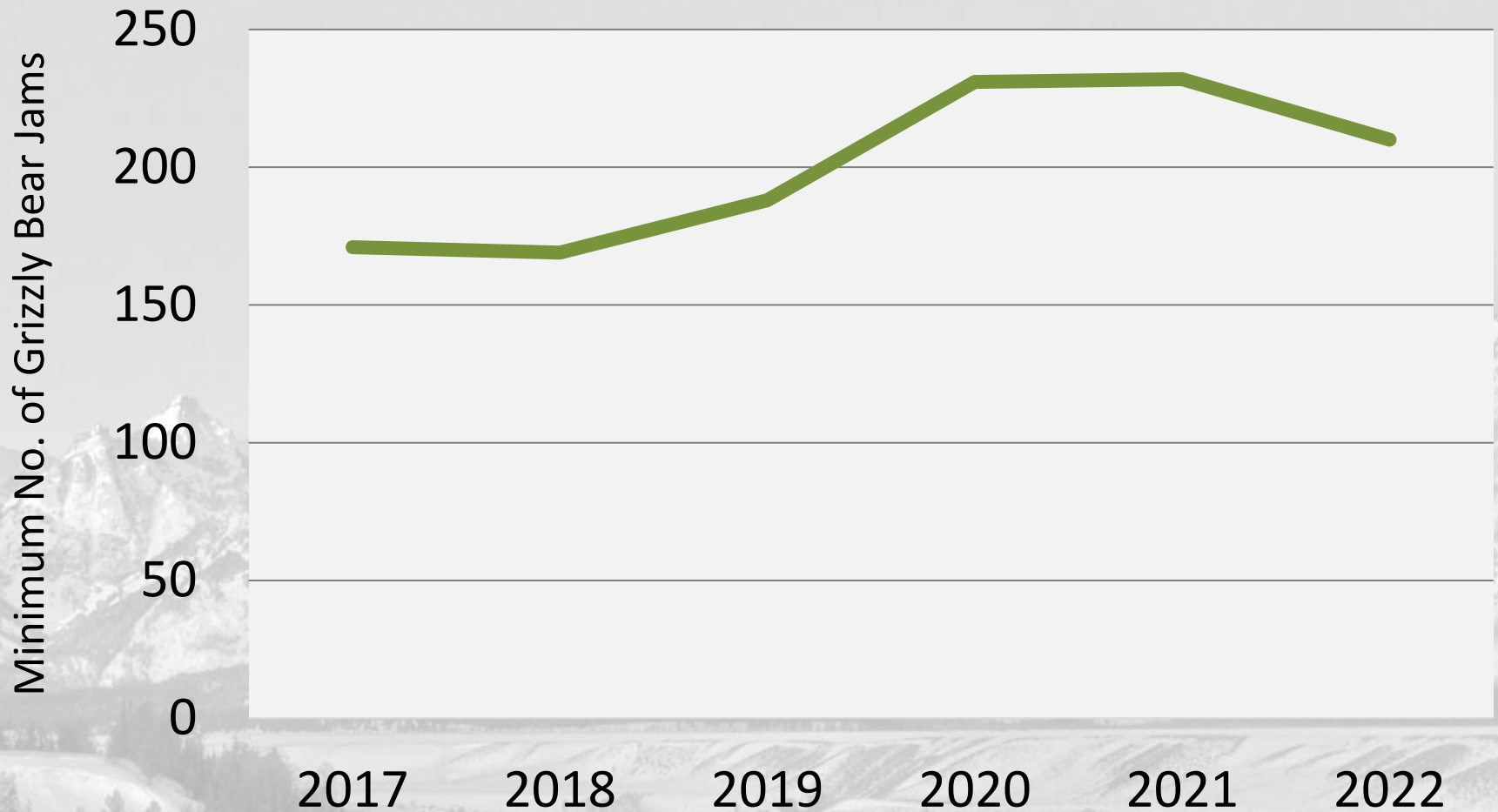
Bear Jams

Minimum of **210 grizzly bear jams**,
which represented 39% of all bear jams in the park in 2022

Wildlife Brigade

Wildlife Brigade volunteers (n = 31)

Bear Education Trailer

Dedicated staffing on **45 days** to provide bear safety education and bear spray demonstrations

Don't let a good day go bad—store your food and trash right.



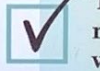
Someone is in arm's reach of your food



OR



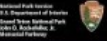
Scented items are put away in bear box or vehicle.
