 - Support revisions to the recovery plan
 - Support development of conservation strategies
 - Support actions by FWS to delist populations upon achievement of
 - Support revisions to CSs as warranted by new info

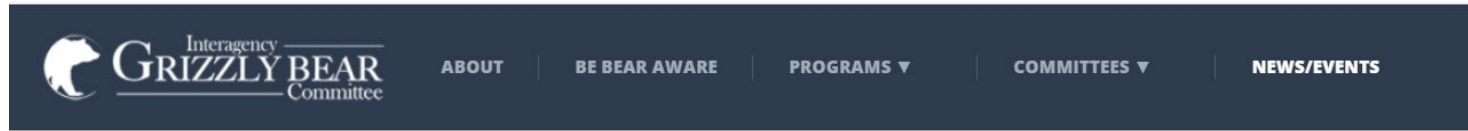

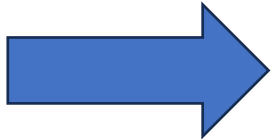
